- New directions and the start of Satellite Bible Colleges beyond Tatarstan made possible by Graham relinquishing some responsibilities and taking up new ones. It has been a period of continuity and change which has given new energy.
- Having wonderful and steady support for the work. It is thrilling to feel that a 'home team' of family and friends is behind every teaching trip - caring and praying.
- November saw the beginnings of an invigorating, new partnership with the minister of the Resurrection Church in Almaty, Kazakhstan - Audrey Muzhchil. A highly successful Bible School was launched with the teaching of the Books of Moses to some 50 church leaders and pastors.
- In January Graham and Juliet shared together in a teaching trip to the Mission College in Kazan. Local churches had requested teaching on marriage and family life which we gave in a Bible talk with following discussion. It was very well received and there have been a number of other requests so that we are now planning a day conference in October 2016.

Together with Operation Mobilisation Paris, the churches in the city are preparing for a week of evangelism, during the week of **2nd - 9th July**, to coincide with the final of the European Cup here in Marseille. In our district we have two major events which we ask you to pray for.

† There will be a team of about 14 young people from all over Europe who are coming to run a football camp with young people from the area. This is a sort of 'soft evangelism' where the aim is to get to know the families and let them know that Christians exist in their neighbourhood and have fun like everyone else!

† The other activity will be more direct door to door work when we will try to talk about the Gospel and follow up those who are interested by offering a course to introduce them to the Christian faith.

It is essential to pray for all of this, not just because it is a massive undertaking to organise, but also because following up people in this area is difficult, due mainly to their irregularity and unreliability

The year has begun and much blessing has come with it. The church in downtown Santiago has been growing in love and service. It is very exciting to see how God is at work in people's lives. Every Sunday we are receiving newcomers. There is an average attendance

of about 75-80 people per week and the small groups that meet in homes grew from four in 2015 to eight this year.

As a pastor I'm excited to tell you that our church is beginning to train leaders. Every Monday I meet with the newish people – those that have been coming to church since last year. It's a way in which they can get to know the church from within and also to get to know how the gospel affects everything we think and do as a community. From the other side, I meet every Thursday with the small group leaders to study the book of Romans. It's one way in which we spend time together with God's word and deepen our understanding of the gospel. But at the same time it is my way of helping them to take a lead with the pastoral issues they face every week in their own small groups.

The month of May has been a hectic one. Over the first weekend, we had our annual Family Retreat as a church. It was a very good time. We spent good time in God's word and in community.

We do not take you for granted and give thanks to God for you all.
